As part of your child's curriculum and the development, they will have opportunity to access a wide range of Computing resources, including supervised access to the Internet. We recognise the important contribution and value such resources play in promoting children's learning and development, however, there are potential risks involved. We therefore have rigorous online safety policy and procedures in place and have taken positive steps to reduce this risk in school. Our school Internet provider; Oakford Technology operates a filtering system that restricts access to inappropriate materials.

The school will not be liable for any damages arising from your child's use of the Internet facilities.
