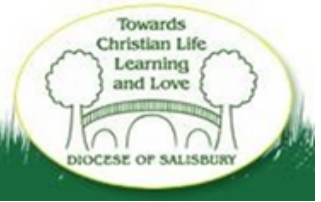

Loving God, thank you for this school year.

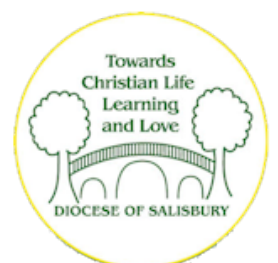

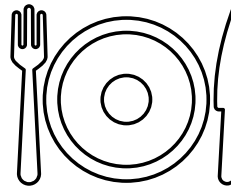
Good bye Miss Sainsbury!

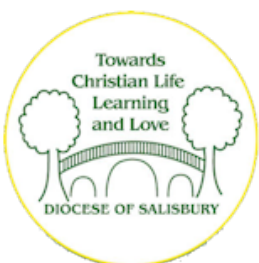


School Lunches update
