Please can we remind you that the children should be in school by 8.40 am.





Our friendly PTA hold a regular Friday morning coffee morning straight after drop off. Everyone is welcome -enjoy a coffee and a chat.





Dates for your diary

As we begin the new term, here are a few important reminders:

1. Bad Weather Alerts: In the event of severe weather, please check the school website and Parent Pay for updates regarding closures or changes to the schedule.
