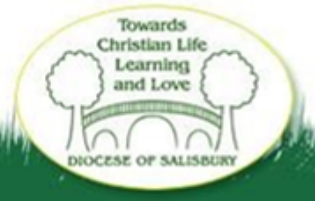

### School Value-Hope

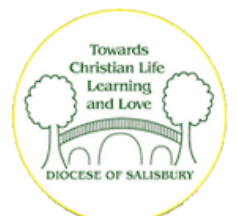

### Attendance

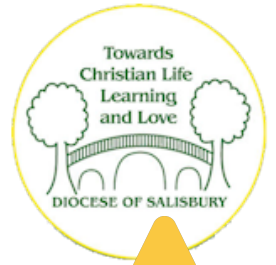

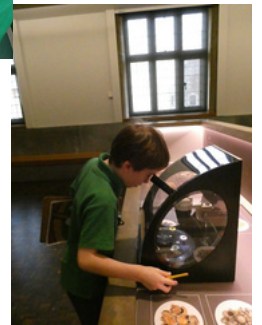
Upper Woodford Class have been busy designing and making their own Easter bags.
