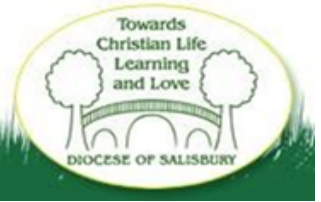

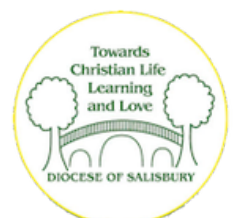


Attendance

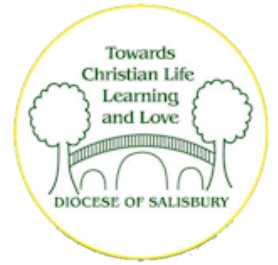
After School Club Survey

Staffing news...

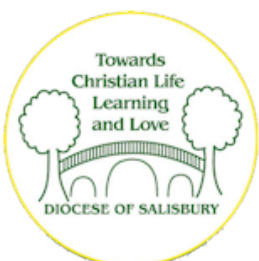
Mrs Ruth Massie will be stepping down from teaching Yr 2 on a Monday from September. Angie Smith-TA- will be leaving us at the end of term 6.
