The School has a responsibility to:

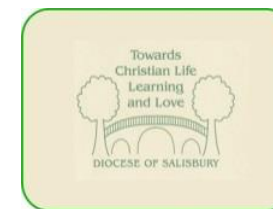
- ✓ Build good relationships in the spirit of a Christian community;
- ✓ Value every member of the school community;
- ✓ Welcome parents and community into school;
- ✓ Plan work carefully to suit the needs of all children;
- ✓ Help children to reach their potential;
- ✓ Talk to parents regularly about their child's progress;
- ✓ Create an environment in which good behaviour and hard work are expected, encouraged and praised;
- ✓ Ensure all children are treated fairly;
- ✓ Ensure that the school is a safe environment in which all children feel happy;
- ✓ Maintain good levels of communication with parents to keep them well informed;
- ✓ Contact families if there are concerns.
- ✓ To make pupils aware of E safety rules within school and to use at home as well

We ask families to support children by:

- Giving lots of praise and encouragement;
- Encouraging active participation in school activities and be willing to represent the school when chosen to do so;
- Expecting them to be well behaved at school and support the school rules;
- Supporting homework activities and ensuring that it is handed in on time;
- Listening to reading regularly;
- Making sure children come to school at the right time, appropriately dressed and with the right equipment;
- Updating contact numbers and writing letters of explanation for absence;
- Attending Parent's Evenings when possible;
- Avoiding taking family holidays during term time;
- Making sure all uniform is labelled clearly;
- Keeping school well informed about any situation which may affect them;
- Bringing a healthy lunchbox and healthy snacks for playtimes
- To keep children aware of E -Safety rules

We ask children to:

- ✘ Be kind, considerate and polite to all members of the school community;
- ✘ Support the school in all activities such as sport and music;
- ✘ Try to do their best at all times;
- ✘ Take care of our school environment;
- ✘ Take care of school equipment;
- ✘ Behave well and follow the school rules; including e-safety
- ✘ Remember to bring all necessary items to school (reading folders, homework, PE kit);
- ✘ Give letters from school to your parents/guardian;
- ✘ Always try to work neatly, if possible;
- ✘ Tell a member of staff if there is a problem.
