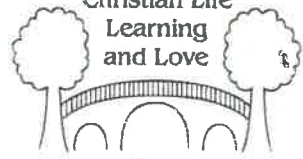

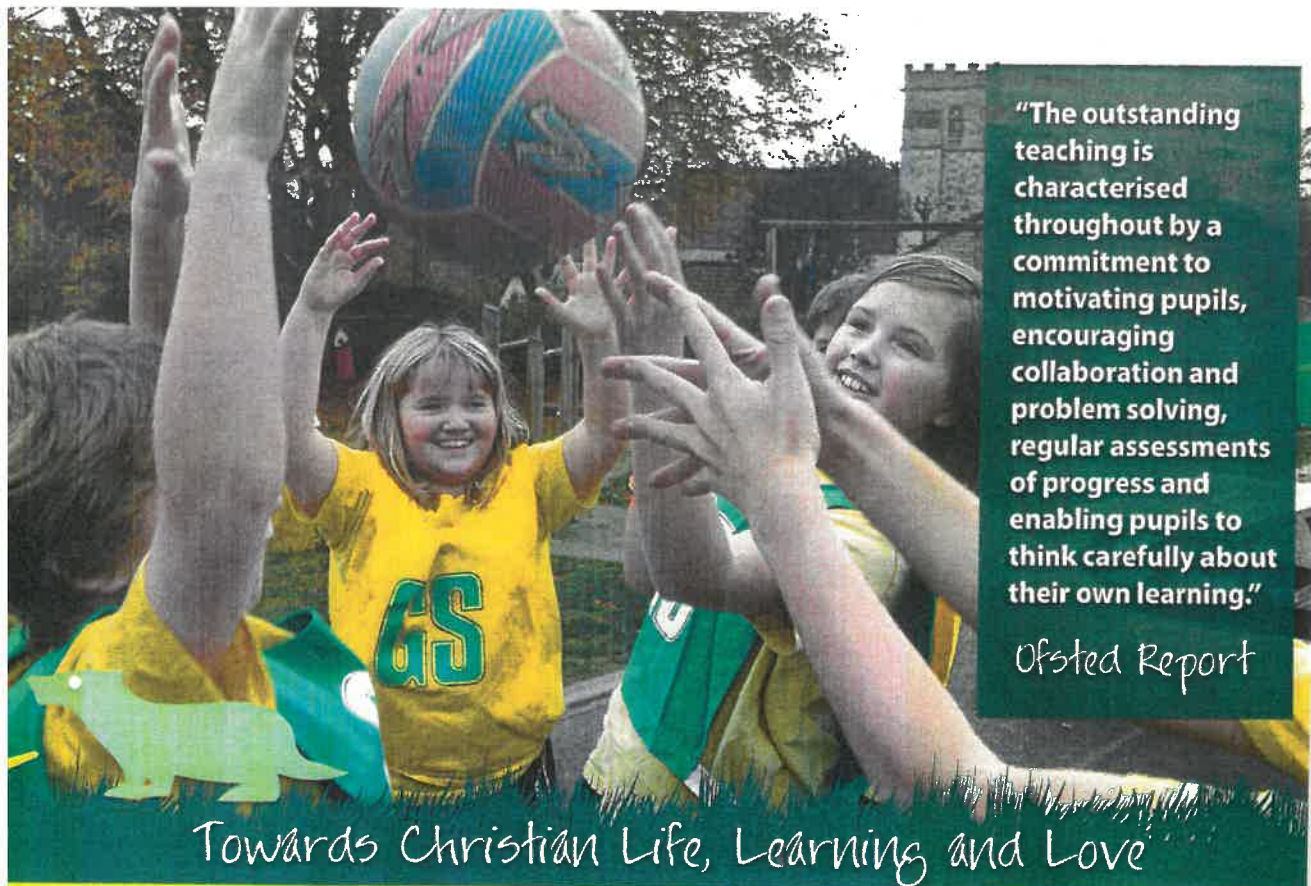

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Making Woodford Valley School a great place to be

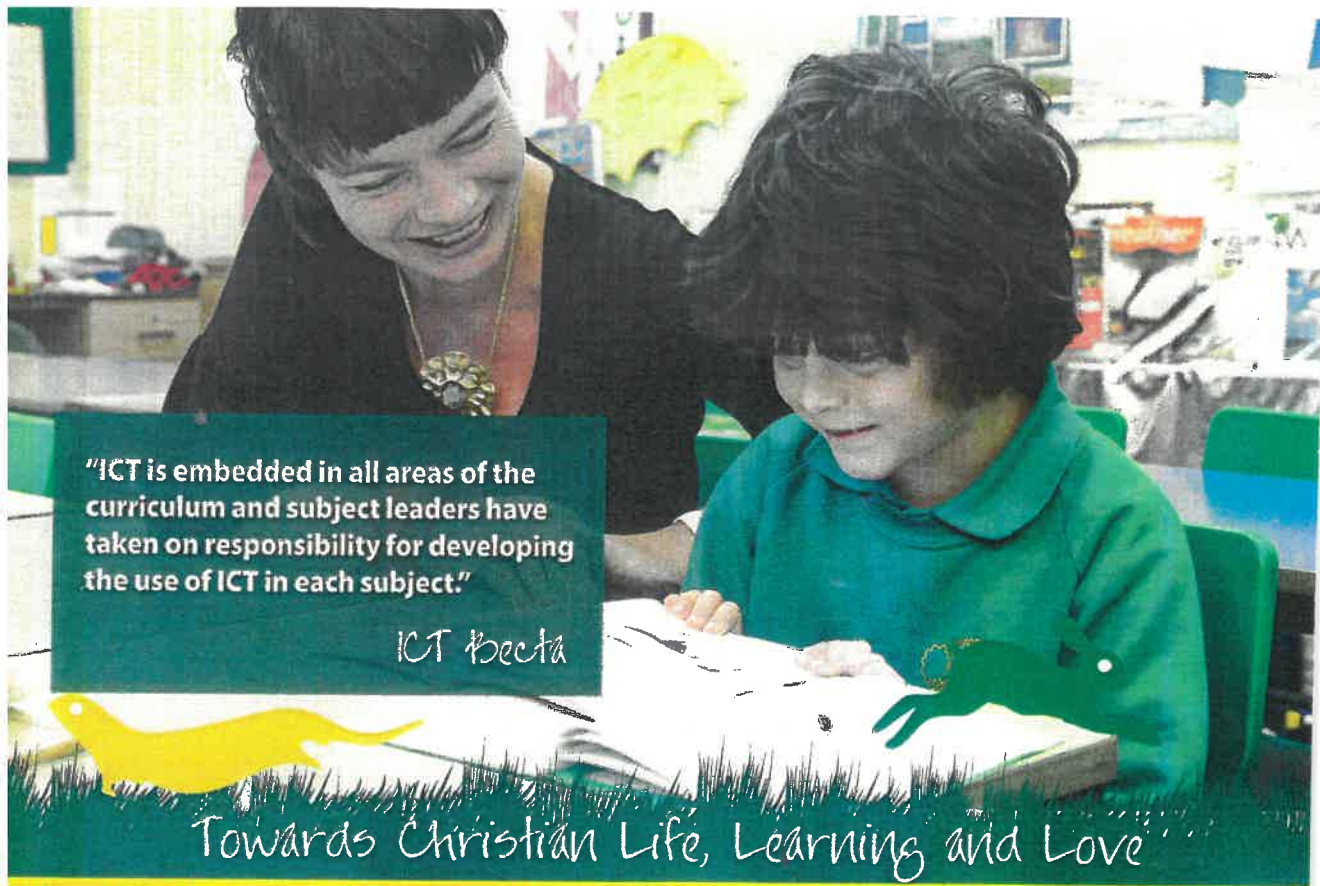

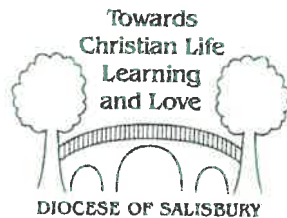
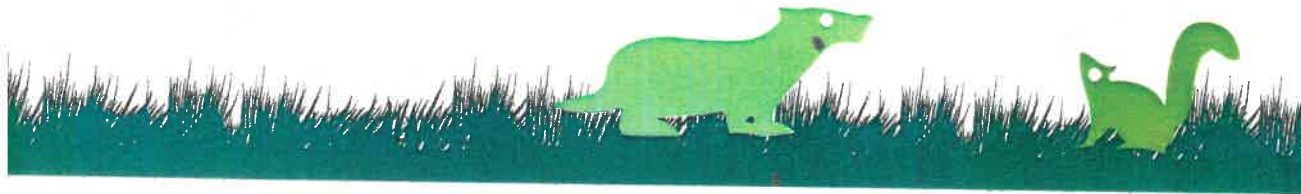
We believe our pupils are the best in the world!
