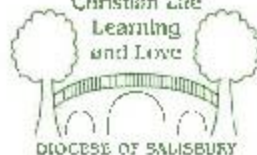

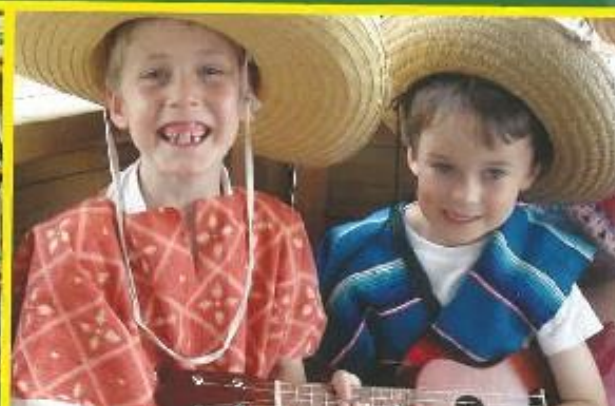


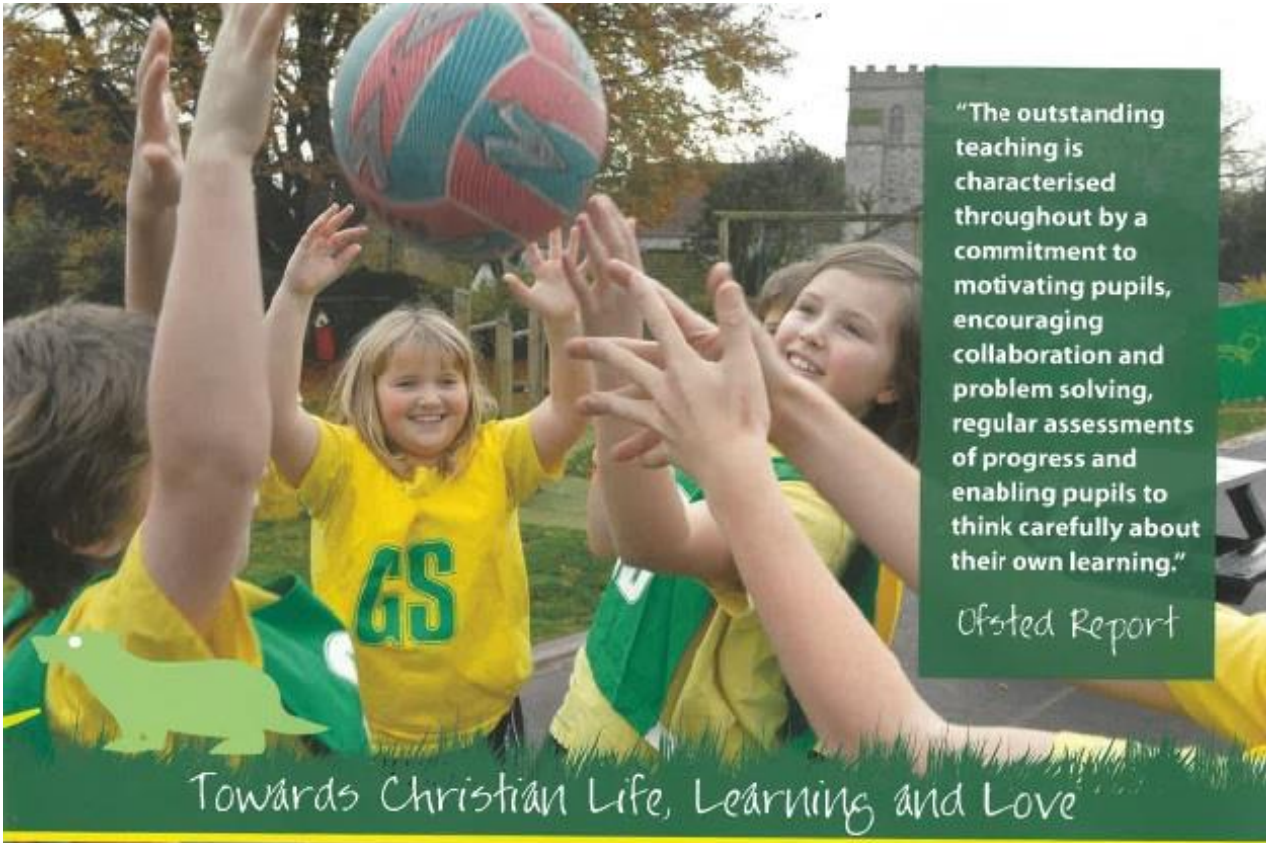
The teamwork which helps us reach for the stars
